Over ensuing decades new batch plants, products, admixtures and agitator trucks were regularly added to Mawsons' Concrete business. Concretors, Builders, Contractors and Government Authorities became regular customers and great partnerships were formed. Hundreds of thousands, then millions, of cubic metres of concrete were poured. Homes, factories, warehouses, piggeries, dairies, hatcheries, hotels, motels, schools, hospitals, swimming pools, bridges, weirs, water tanks and underground mines; many now over 50 years old, stand as testament to the ingenuity and skills of the people who make and place Mawsons' concrete.

Today, Mawsons take great pride in offering a wide range of Normal, Special and Decorative mixes across a broad swath of regional Victoria and southern New South Wales. With a large fleet of modern maxi and mini delivery trucks equipped with the latest safety and mixing equipment, specialist technical support and plenty of good, old fashioned experience, Mawsons offer an unrivalled level of service to support their quality products.

Mawsons have an independently certified National Association of Testing Authorities (NATA) concrete testing laboratory in Echuca. A dedicated team of qualified Mawsons' engineers manage this facility, designing concrete mixes and monitoring production and performance to ensure that customer requirements are consistently satisfied in a timely manner right across the broad service area. Mawsons also operate on-site, NATA registered laboratories at each of their major quarries, to monitor aggregate and sand production quality in real time.

To help protect our people and customers Mawsons have sophisticated Work Health and Safety and Training systems. Safety is the number one priority at all Mawsons' worksites; all employees and contractors are actively involved in minimizing and controlling hazards. Specialist staff work with operations people to develop and manage safe work practices and risk controls that are effective and practical. Mawsons' workplace safety performance is amongst the best in the construction and mining sectors.

Mawsons' on-going training programs give employees the most up-to-date safety skills and practical technical knowhow. Using recognised local and national training providers, both on-the-job and in classrooms, Mawsons' programs ensure that people are skilled in their jobs. In 2019 Mawsons' 350 employees attended almost 600 documented internal training sessions

and over 700 external training programs across many disciplines from concrete testing to safe truck driving and crane operation.

Out of respect for our regional communities Mawsons are active supporters of local sporting clubs, schools, emergency services and charities. Mawsons are registered members of Social Traders and have a genuine engagement with Social Procurement right across the business.

Workforce diversity in the Construction and Quarrying industries is typically low. Mawsons have a comprehensive Inclusion Policy, supported by programs to recruit and develop a modern workforce with increased female, youth and indigenous participation throughout the business.

Using modern, low emission, fuel efficient machinery, lower CO₂ generating supplementary cementitious materials and electricity from renewables helps to further reduce Mawsons' environmental footprint.
